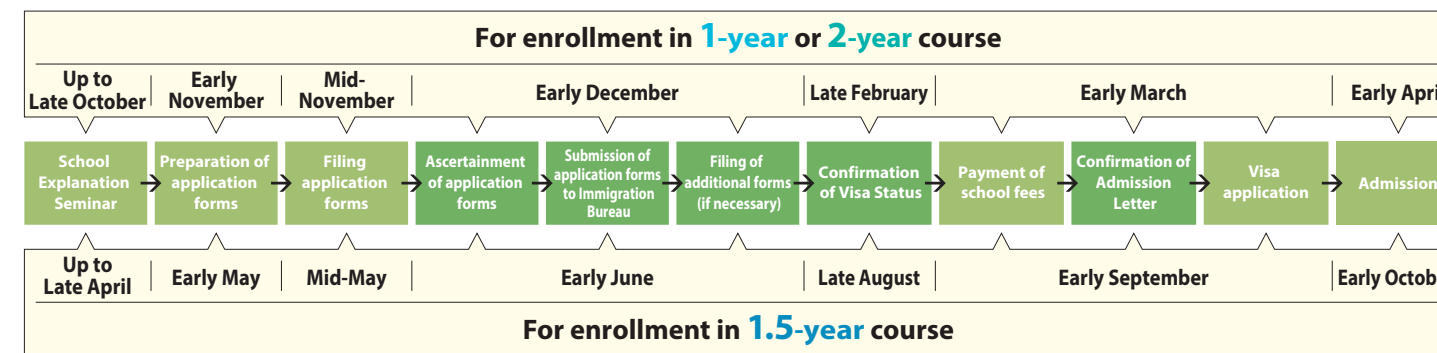

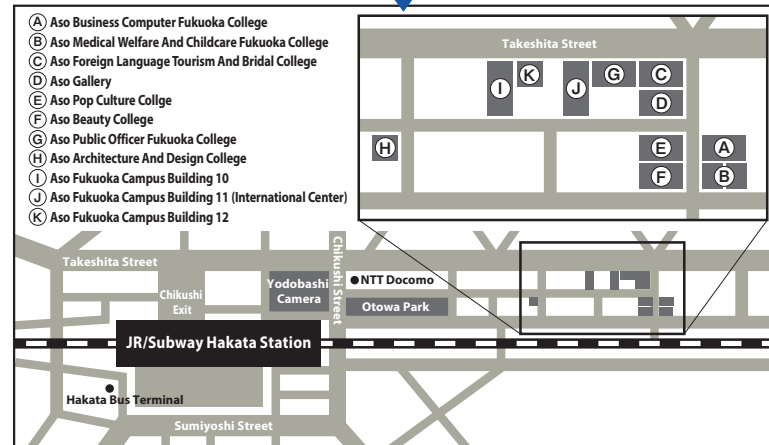

Japanese Language Course

The course provides a language learning environment for individuals who wish to enter a Japanese university, graduate school, or technical college, and go on to work in Japan or abroad. The course also accepts individuals who have goals other than further education, such as working in Japan.



Curriculum

Listen, Speak, Read and Write Japanese. Our Curriculum Boosts Your Skills in Each Area.

Classes are organized by level, so students receive instruction that matches their Japanese language ability. A support curriculum that includes test preparation is also provided to help students meet their goals, such as passing the JLPT at different levels.

Japanese students study on the same campus, so it is a rich learning environment!

You will study on the same campus as Japanese students, and study with them in an environment that gives you contact with real-world Japanese language.

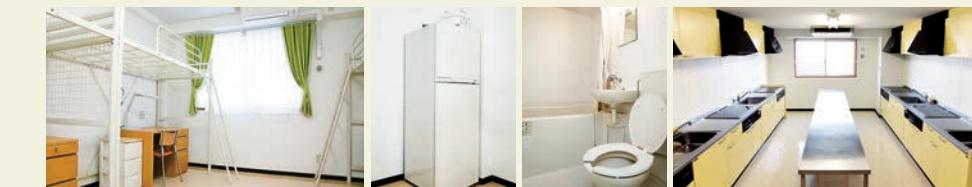
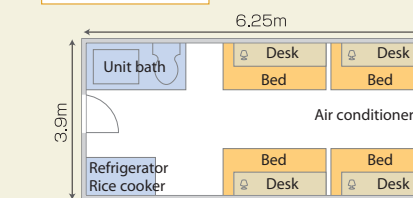
- 15 min. by bicycle to the school
