- Educational Background: Must be 18 years or older as of April 1, 2025, and have completed 12 years of education (equivalent to high school) or equivalent.
- Finances: Must have sufficient funds for tuition and living expenses during the period of study.
- Japanese Language Proficiency: Must meet one of the following requirements and be able to participate in classes conducted in Japanese:
 - ① Passed JLPT N1 or N2
 - ② Scored 200 or above on the Japanese language section of the EJU
 - $\ensuremath{\,^{\circlearrowleft}}$ Scored 400 or above on the BJT Business Japanese Proficiency Test
- MI Tokyo Only: Submission of a performance or singing video is required.

Entrance Exam

- AO Admissions: Interview (approximately 15 minutes)
- Regular Admissions: Written exam (waived if you meet one of the Japanese language proficiency requirements ① to ③), essay, and interview.

Tuition Fees

- First Year: ¥1,500,000 (includes ¥200,000 admission fee)
- Second Year: ¥1,300,000

Note: Tuition fees, except for the admission fee, can be paid in two installments. Generally, the annual tuition covers all class expenses.

Scholarships for International Students

- ESP Gakuen International Student Learning Encouragement Scholarship: ¥160,000 per year (¥80,000 x 2)
- ESP Gakuen JLPT Scholarship: ¥100,000 for N1 / ¥50,000 for N2
- ESP Gakuen Language Education Institution Recommendation
 Scholarship: ¥50,000
- ESP Gakuen Enrollment Preparation Program: ¥100,000 (application before arrival in Japan)
