Academics

Overview

The Global Business Course (GBC) was established in the School of Economics and Management in 2019 and is located in the Kobe Campus for Commerce. The GBC is the first program taught only in English at the University of Hyogo. Each year, about 30 international students and 50 Japanese students are enrolled in the program.

What We Offer

In the GBC, students learn together in a multicultural environment. They participate in unique cross-cultural experiences not only by studying in GBC but also by living and communicating with each other in Global House, the international dormitory, as well as in the Center for Global Engagement.

All students study in seminars throughout their 4 years in addition to their other classes. All of the seminars have a small number of students, which is ideal for exchanging ideas and thoughts with classmates and professors.

Study Japanese and Experience Japan

GBC international students take Japanese language classes as well as classes to learn about and experience Japan. They begin with intensive language courses suitable to their level of Japanese, from beginner to advanced, in order to make their new lives in Japan easier. After this, they continue the systematic study of Japanese as well as take classes to increase their understanding of Japanese culture and Japanese Economics and Management practices.

Economics and Management

One of the unique strengths of the GBC is that its curriculum provides students with opportunities to study both economics and management from the basics to advanced levels in English. Through studying theories of economics and management, GBC students learn how to put theories into practice and how to make decisions based on these theories.

In addition, there are exciting fieldwork and internship opportunities. The University of Hyogo enjoys unique connections with major enterprises located in Kobe and elsewhere in Hyogo Prefecture, and such connections allow GBC students to join internship programs and have opportunities for actual experience to deepen their understanding of Japanese enterprises.

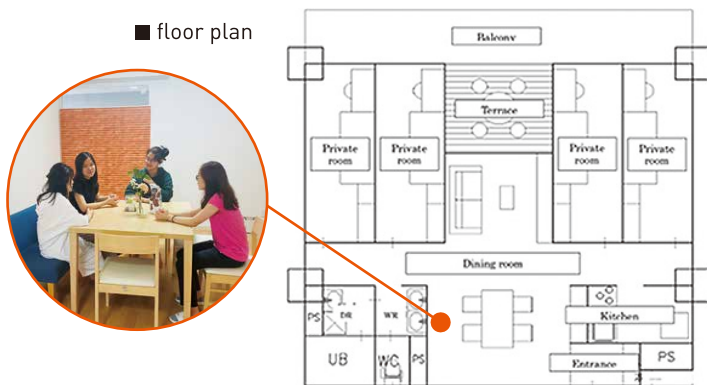
Raising Global Leaders

International Domitory

All GBC students are required to live in the on-campus, international dormitory, the Global House, for their first year. Three or four students share the same unit, which includes a kitchen, living room, and bathroom. However, each student has their own bedroom where they can enjoy privacy.

Students who become Resident Assistants (RA) live in Global House in their second year, as well. RAs act as leaders in the dormitory, support the new students, and create a comfortable environment in which everyone can study and socialize as they wish.

After Graduation

GBC students come from a wide range of backgrounds. Upon graduation from the GBC, students will be prepared to pursue many different opportunities. The Career Center can assist students in finding paths that are right each of them.

GBC students have a chance to experience internships in major Japanese companies, whose headquarters are located in Hyogo Prefecture. Furthermore, there is a chance to enroll in the GBC Graduate School in order to further deepen their knowledge of economics and management.



Life at the University of Hyogo

Financial Aids/Exemptions/Scholarships

All international GBC students are granted a 50% reduction in tuition for 4 years. Also, from the second year until the 4th year, students with grades in the top 30% are exempted from paying tuition.

In addition, the University of Hyogo offers other forms of financial aid. Thanks to the generosity of donors, international GBC students are entitled to receive startup aid in their first year. Other scholarships include JASSO and private scholarships exclusively for international students.

Counseling

If students have any concerns about their physical, mental, or emotional health or well-being, there is a healthcare center on campus, where students have access to counseling in English on a regular basis.

Club Activities

There are variety of club activities at the Kobe Campus for Commerce. Students can participate in clubs such as soccer, Japanese archery, dance, or music, or they can start their own. Also, every year in autumn, the University Festival, Shodaisai, is held.

Application Eligibility

■ Requirement 1: Educational Qualifications

(1) Applicants **MUST** have completed, or are expected to complete, a 12-year standard education curriculum at an educational institution, equivalent to a Japanese 12-year official education curriculum.

*Note that those who attended Japanese junior and/or senior high school for up to three years in total are eligible to apply.

(2) Those who are acknowledged to have completed, or are expected to complete, a curriculum equivalent to 12 years of Japanese education.

■ Requirement 2: English Proficiency

Applicants **MUST** achieve score on a standardized English proficiency exam that is equivalent to the B2 level of the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) or higher.

(Please refer to the latest Application Guidelines.)

Screening Method

Students will be selected based on their application documents and an interview.

The interview will be conducted in English, either locally or through the Internet.

Applicants residing outside Japan do not need to come to Japan for the interview.
