

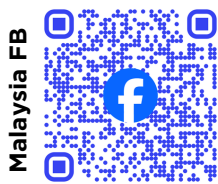

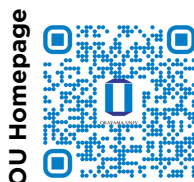

Okayama has a perfect mixture of urban and nature sites. It is located between Hiroshima and Kobe with easy access from Tokyo and Osaka.

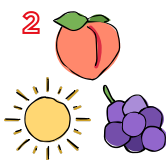
